The Government drafts and submits project proposals for further financing by the EU








# **EU projects in Uzbekistan**

37 projects with a total budget 103 million EUR.

15 national projects (69,92 million EUR).

22 regional projects (33,08 million EUR).

**Projects focus on:** rural development, small and private entrepreneurship, security, <u>education</u>, etc.







In the education field we work with the several departments of EC, such as GD International Cooperation and Development (DEVCO), GD Education, Youth, Sport and Culture (EAC), EA Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA), EA European Research Council Executive Agency (ERCEA)
