Capacity Building in Higher Education (CBHE)

- **Transnational cooperation projects** based on multilateral partnerships primarily between **higher education institutions (HEIs)**
- **2 or 3 years'** duration (Min. 500,000 - Max. 1,000,000 €)
- Consortium: **Programme Countries and Partner Countries**
- Types of projects: **Joint & Structural**
- Deadline: **8th February 2018**

Novelties in CBHE



- Only 3 thematic priority areas instead of 4, according to project types
- Only 2 Programme Countries needed for eligible consortium
- Start of the eligibility period:
 - 15 November 2018 or
 - 15 January 2019

Key messages CBHE



- **Attention to eligibility criteria!**
- **New national and regional priorities!**
- **Avoid overlapping** with existing projects in the same subject area/priorities
- **Ensure to bring an innovative approach:** be innovative in the content and methodologies described in your application.
- **Invest on the ownership of the projects objectives and results:** need to empower the Partner Country partners from the early stages of the proposal preparation



International Credit Mobility

- Credit mobility between Programme and Partner Countries
- For students and staff (for learning and teaching)
- Action managed by National Agencies located in Europe **decentralised**
- Deadline: **1st February 2018**





Novelties in ICM

- All levels of higher education (Short cycle, Bachelor, Master, Doctoral levels)
- All disciplines
- From 3 to 12 months for studies
- From 2 to 12 months for traineeships
- Staff mobility for teaching and training *from 2 days (5 days from and to Partner Countries) to 2 months, excluding travel time*





Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree (EMJMD)

- Highly integrated Master study programmes delivered by international
- HEI consortium
- No restriction in disciplines
- 4 consecutive student intakes
- Full scholarships for students - 75% for students from Partner Countries (Heading 1 and Heading 4/EDF Windows scholarships together)
- Award of a joint or multiple Master degree
- Deadline: **15 February 2018**

Erasmus Mundus



Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree (EMJMD)

- Integrated international Master programmes of excellent quality to attract the very best students worldwide
- Developed and delivered by a consortium of HEIs from Programme Countries & Partner Countries (if relevant)
- Duration 12 – 18 – 24 months (60 – 90 – 120 ECTS credits), optional preparatory year + 4 intakes (6 years maximum) – covered by one Grant Agreement
- Mandatory study period in at least 2 different Programme Countries (no virtual mobility)
- Fully recognised and accredited joint / multiple Master degrees



Jean Monnet

- Focus on **EU studies** to promote **excellence** in **teaching and research on the European integration process** in various disciplines
- European Union studies comprise the **study of Europe in its entirety** with particular **emphasis on the European Integration process in both its internal and external aspects**
