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## Capacity Building in Higher Education (CBHE)

- **Transnational cooperation projects** based on multilateral partnerships primarily between **higher education institutions (HEIs)**
- **2 or 3 years'** duration (Min. 500,000 - Max. 1,000,000 €)
- Consortium: **Programme Countries and Partner Countries**
- Types of projects: **Joint & Structural**
- Deadline: **8<sup>th</sup> February 2018**

## Novelties in CBHE



- Only 3 thematic priority areas instead of 4, according to project types
- Only 2 Programme Countries needed for eligible consortium
- Start of the eligibility period:
  - 15 November 2018 or
  - 15 January 2019



## Key messages CBHE

- **Attention to eligibility criteria!**
- **New national and regional priorities!**

- **Avoid overlapping** with existing projects in the same subject area/priorities
- **Ensure to bring an innovative approach:** be innovative in the content and methodologies described in your application.
- **Invest on the ownership of the projects objectives and results:** need to empower the Partner Country partners from the early stages of the proposal preparation



## Recommendations based on FM visits

- **Rectors of HEIs should have all information about the particular project**
- **Project teams should include HEI's staff from different departments considering their** (managerial, language, topic related, IT and other skills) **+ IRD staff**
- **Dissemination activities should be started in parallel with the project's realisation:**
  - HEIs' websites should provide full information about the project in local languages
  - Project's website on local hosting should be organised
